At this year’s Summer Enrichment children will participate in hands-on activities that excite the mind and engage the imagination, by using favorite children’s themes and classic children’s literature! There will be stories, songs, games, arts and crafts and plenty of time for the open-ended imaginative play that builds important skills like problem-solving and getting along with others! Children will enjoy learning across the curriculum -- including art, poetry, classic stories, Bible stories, math, science, geography, and history! Summer Enrichment is a great way to both introduce your child to the world of school or bridge the summer gap between grades. Field trips may be included as appropriate. Most staffing will be provided by the wonderful teachers of Saint John Lutheran School.

Our active summer program is available eight weeks – you can choose to come just one or all weeks, come all five days or just two, come all day or just half a day, or any mixture of the above! The Summer Program is offered the following weeks:

Classes will be offered on a 2-day, 3-day, or 5-day basis.

You may sign up for the Summer Enrichment class (9 am to 12 noon) only, or the class plus extended care (7:30 am to 6 pm).

Children are grouped by age, with no more than 10 children per teacher or assistant.

To register, parents will need to:

1. Fill out a registration form and health form, with immunization & negative TB test documentation, if one is not already on file in the school office from the previous or upcoming school year
2. Provide proof of identity in the form of a birth certificate (if not already on file)
3. Fill out an attendance schedule form
4. Pay the appropriate registration fee

Registrations should be received by the school no later than May 28, 2010, in order to reserve a spot. Early enrollments are highly encouraged so that we can have adequate planning time for staff and ordering materials. Each week’s tuition will be due in advance, by the Friday previous to the scheduled week.

*Once your child’s schedule is set substitution of days is not allowed.

*Days missed for any reason are not reimbursable, nor are they allowed to be made up on a different day.

Enrollment Requirements and Program Information

- ⊗ Children must be at least 26 months old by June 30, 2010 (2 years old by 4/30/10).
- ⊗ Toilet training is required for children 3 ½ years old and older.
- ⊗ Children should bring a snack each day for the 9-12 class.
- ⊗ Children in afternoon extended care must bring a lunch.
- ⊗ Children should be dressed for the weather and for practicality. **Slip-on shoes and sandals are not allowed**, for safety reasons.
- ⊗ Some student groups may go on field trips related to their theme of study. Transportation by car-pool and permission slips are required. Children are required to be in a car safety or booster seat. Any fees involved will be the responsibility of the parents.
- ⊗ Children enrolled in afternoon extended care must be picked up no later than 6:00 p.m.! The late pick-up fee is \$1.00 per minute.
- ⊗ The Summer Enrichment Program operates within the school's general policies and procedures as detailed in the Parent Handbook, many of which are listed above. If you do not have access to a Handbook, please inquire in the school office.
